Based on the Constitution of the CIMFC, membership is defined as follows:

They are members of the Confederation of Christian Family Movement (MFC) even when they have other names if they satisfy the following basic requirements:

- A. They are organized in small groups of married couples, families, single-parents, widows/widowers. etc. who search for genuine family communities and cooperate/work jointly with their counselor(s)/director(s) to promote mutual growth/development.**
- B. They meet regularly, participating in a formative process of *seeing, judging* (= *discerning*) and bringing to light the Word of the Lord.**
- C. They are witnesses and ministers of all families specially of those in difficult situations like the suffering and the poor.**
