30th July

31th July

In the morning, visit of **Coimbra**, rich city of palaces, monuments and by the most ancient university of Portugal. Visit of the University and of the Library.


Lunch in a traditional restaurant in **Mealhada**, where it is possible to eat the famous suckling pig typical of this small city.

1st August

Visit of the second biggest city of Portugal. Visit to the historical centre with his numerous palaces and monuments, and to the Palace of the Stock Exchange. Lunch in local restaurant. The tour continues up to the wine cellars of the famous Port. Tasting of Port wine and visit of one of the wine cellars.
Accommodation in hotel of Oporto.

2nd August

Visit of Minho, the most Northern province of Portugal and region of the green wine. **Guimarães**, cradle of the nationality - stopping in the Sacred Hill - castle and palace of the Dukes of Bragança. **Braga**, city of archbishops and capital of the Christian faith with the most ancient cathedral of the country and the Sanctuary of Good Jesus de Braga with his monumental baroque staircase.

Continuation up to **Viana do Castelo** and visit of the historical centre with the Cathedral Cathedral (century XV) and the ancient Town Hall in the Square of the Republic.
